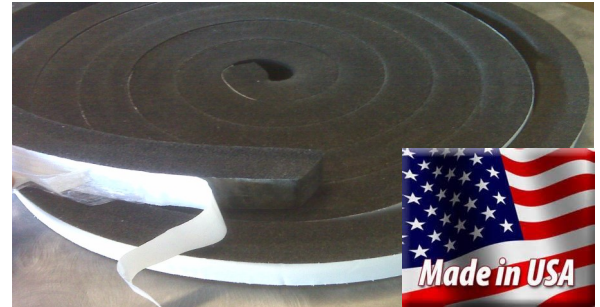


Direct*Seal Universal Closure Roll

Installation

Peel back adhesive release paper beyond the length of product you need. Adhere adhesive side to metal flashing/ clean surface.

Immediately dispose of release paper in a safe fashion. Do not leave release paper on roofing surface.

Install the metal flashing per panel manufacturers recommendations.

When allowable per panel manufacturers specifications it is suggested the fasteners be installed through the flashing and through the center of the Direct*Seal product into the substrate.

Safety, Based on current data, this product is not hazardous in the meaning of the Hazardous Material Regulations. Do not eat. We recommend that you take care, in use and disposal of this product. Make sure to dispose of adhesive release paper immediately after peeling, do not leave on roof surface.
